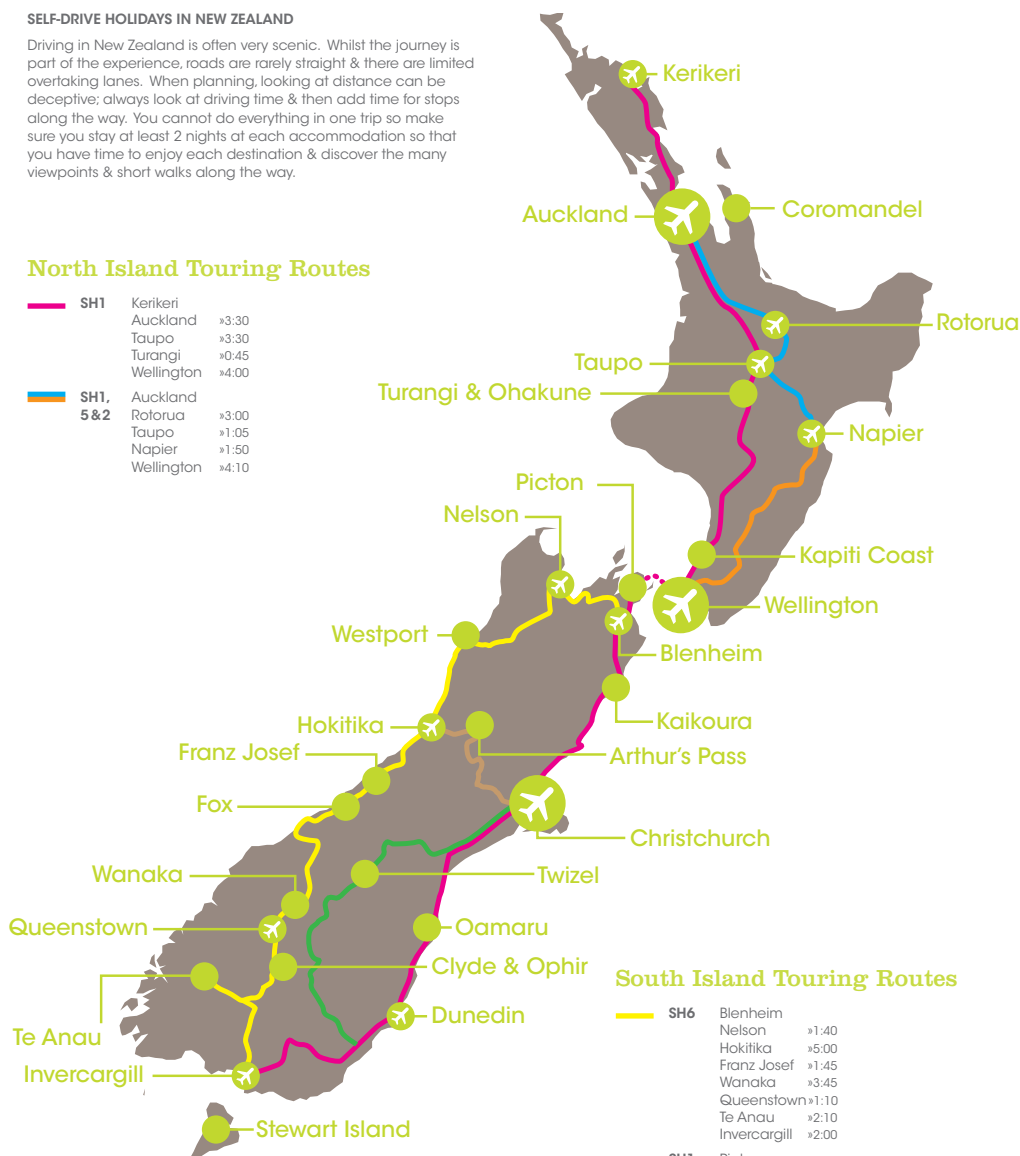
SELF-DRIVE HOLIDAYS IN NEW ZEALAND
